

## ***Senior Final Exam Policies 2023***

### **Exam Reminders -- Teachers please review with your seniors**

- 1) Exam schedules and exam policies will be posted on the WRHS website ([www.wrsd.net/wrhs](http://www.wrsd.net/wrhs)) and outside guidance and upper school offices. In addition, they will be posted in the café and near the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Gym entrance.  
**Please take a moment to review where and when your students will take their exam, and if there is a change in proctor, make them aware of that as well.**

- 2) All seniors are required to take end-of-semester exams (in all of their major subjects. Exams are worth 20% of the semester (two-term) average.  
  
**\*SENIOR Final Exam Exemption** – Only seniors have the opportunity to be exempt from final exams at the end of the school year. In order to be eligible, they must have a semester 2 average equal to or above 90%.
- 3) Students are expected to arrive on time for the exam. Students arriving late will be allowed in but will not receive additional time to complete the exam.
- 4) All seniors must remain in class for the entire 1<sup>st</sup> exam session of the day. Any student who leaves this 1<sup>st</sup> exam session early, will receive a grade of 0 on the exam. Only during the 2<sup>nd</sup> exam session of the day, and upon completion of that 2<sup>nd</sup> exam itself, are seniors permitted to leave early. Any senior who leaves early is expected to exit the building immediately. No loitering will be tolerated.
- 5) Students may be issued a pass to the bathroom during the exam period but will not be allowed to make-up this missed exam time. Teachers may allow only one student out of the room at a time, with a green pass, and have a sign-out sheet to record the time a student leaves and returns. Teachers should remind students who receive a pass to the bathroom that they must return to the exam room (no matter the time) or receive a zero.
- 6) Electronics Devices – Failure to comply with the classroom electronics policy during an exam period will result in a grade of 0 for the exam.

### Make-Up Exams:

1) It is expected that students will take the final exam during the block in which class regularly meets. Teachers should mark students 'A', absent, if the student does not show up for the exam.

2) Make-up exams are allowed only with administrative approval. Mrs. Lapierre will send out a list of students eligible, marked 'VA' on attendance, for make-ups by midmorning of the day following the exam. It is the responsibility of the student to contact the teacher and arrange a time for the make-up exam.

3) It is expected that make-up exams will be completed during exam week and/or scheduled make-up period that takes place the week following exams. ***All exams must be completed by the end of the designated make-up period with the teacher.*** The last day for Senior Make-Up Exams is Monday, June 5th. If that is not possible, then the student must contact his/her administrator about alternative arrangements.

4) Extended absences prior to exam week – if teachers have concerns regarding a student's extended absence prior to exams, please contact the appropriate administrator and guidance counselor so that arrangements may be made for make-up work and exams.

\*Please note, in policies shared with parents & students, we will include the following:

*It is the responsibility of the student and his/her parent(s) to contact the designated school administrators and guidance counselor regarding extended absences just prior to exams that may impact the ability of a student to complete the exam during its designated exam period.*
