WRHS Dance Conduct Policy

The style of dance has become a serious concern to administrators and chaperones of WRHS school dances. Our goal is not to inhibit students' creativity and self expression, but to bring acceptable decorum back to the dances.

The following dance conduct policy is designed to promote a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment at WRHS school dances.

Dance Conduct Guidelines

Please note that these guidelines apply both on and off the dance floor. Sexually suggestive dancing may result in the student being removed from the event, he/she not allowed to attend the next dance, and parent notification.

Sexually suggestive dancing includes but is not limited to:

- No front to back touching/grinding
- No straddling legs
- No bending over
- No touching of the breasts, buttocks, or genitals
- Hands between waist and shoulders only
- No "making out" (overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection)

Consequences may include but are not limited to:

- Meeting with administrator
- Dismissed from the event
- Exclusion from future activities
