### SOME EXAMINATION RULES

1. All students are required to take midyear examinations in all of their major subjects. Midyear exams are worth 20% of the semester (two-term) average. The only exception to the mid-year exam rule is for seniors. Only seniors who have earned an A in an elective class (half year course only) have the opportunity to be exempt from the mid-year exam.
2. In case of a school cancellation, the exam(s) scheduled on that day will be given the next day that school is in session. The remainder of the schedule will proceed in the order of the original schedule.
3. If there is a two-hour delay on exam days, the first exam will be dropped and the schedule will continue in the original order. The dropped exam will be rescheduled for the next full day of school **after** the exam dates.
4. On exam days, students do not need to be in school other than when they have an exam. If a student does not have an exam on Tuesday, January 16, they do not have to be here for the exam time but are expected to be in attendance for all classes after the exam block that day. **Students must remain in the exam room for the full period of the examination. Anyone leaving early will receive a zero for that exam.**
5. The final day for making up a midyear exam is **Tuesday, January 23**. Any exceptions to this make-up date must be approved by the principal. Students are encouraged to make arrangements with their individual teachers to make up exams during free blocks or after school during exam week. Unless otherwise arranged, make-up exams will take place in room **H103/H105 on Monday and Tuesday, January 22 & January 23, from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m.**
6. Students **are not** allowed to use personal electronic devices if they finish their exam early.
7. If students are in the building during a period they do not have an examination, they must stay out of the corridors. The cafeteria and gym will be open for those students.
